

# New Testaments for free... it's working!

The sure you feel the same way I do that the Word of God is precious —more precious than pure gold, and sweeter than honey from the honeycomb (Psalm 19:10). And if you are anything like me then you have several copies and versions on your shelves. We have this love for Scripture in common with the global Jewish community. My people treasure the Hebrew Scriptures like we do—perhaps, for some, even more so.

Study of sacred texts is a very central part of Jewish culture. That's why it breaks my heart that most of my people have never read the New Testament. The New Testament is a Jewish book, by Jewish authors, about the Jewish Hope. And yet the life changing words of this book have been kept from my people for over two thousand years. They have been taught that this book is forbidden, never to be opened.

In Israel, not only is the New Testament not read and studied, it is extremely difficult to access a copy. Our Hebrew Jews for Jesus website is one of the only places in the country where an Israeli can receive a copy of the New Testament in their native language. In 2021 we were able to connect 700 Israeli seekers with a Hebrew New Testament Bible. Hand delivering these Bibles provides us with a unique opportunity to develop personal connections with non-believing Israelis. Each week, through our website we receive about two dozen requests for this Bible.

This year, our goal is to not only give away, but to connect with 1,000 Israelis through the gift of the New Testament. We are so fortunate that several different Christian organizations in Israel have given us free copies of Hebrew New Testaments to give away. The cost to get these Bible into the hands of Israelis, covers staff (who physically distribute and connect with those asking for the Bible), storage of the Bibles, website fees, promotional events, and postage for those requesting mailed copies. In order for us to get the Hebrew New Testaments in the hands of 1,000 Israeli seekers it will cost \$150,000, which is \$150 per Bible.

Knowing the plentiful access I have to the Scriptures here in the United States, I am filled with gratitude—as well as a deep sense of responsibility to make sure that every Jewish person who wants to read the New Testament can get access to one. Will you help me bring this forbidden book to Jewish seekers with an additional generous gift?

Our missionaries hand-deliver these precious Bibles as soon and as often as possible, so they can also offer prayer, share their testimony, and come back later for another visit. This creates opportunities to discuss the Scriptures and opens the door for ongoing ministry and discipleship. That's exactly what happened with Shiloh.\* Shiloh requested from us a copy of the Bible that had both Hebrew and English in it. Our missionary Jeff brought Shiloh the New Testament at his house. Shiloh fought back tears as he said "I've been looking for this book." He had heard about Jesus and believed that He was the way to God, but no one had ever explained the gospel to him.

Shiloh began attending church and Bible study with Jeff over the next couple of months, soon boldly professing his faith in Jesus as his Saviour and Lord. As we began to disciple Shiloh, he spoke frequently about how happy he was to have discovered the hope and truth of the gospel. Yet his heart was troubled because his wife and children do not know Yeshua as Messiah.

Soon after sharing his belief with his family, Shiloh asked his wife to attend church with him—and she did! In fact, she enjoyed the service and community of believers so much that she asked, "May I keep attending even though I don't believe in Jesus?" Praise God! Please pray with us that she too comes to know the Lord as she hears the message of Jesus each week.

At Shiloh's baptism, he testified to the witnesses gathered there that day and said, "I carry scars on my soul and body from almost six decades of a wandering journey during which I came close to death several times, including almost drowning in a swimming pool when I was young. I find it symbolic to be reborn now Because of your support, missionaries today are coming alongside Jewish seekers to help them not only gain access to the Word of God, but also to understand its words and then welcoming new brothers and sisters into our family in Messiah!

in another swimming pool, receiving forgiveness for my past sins and a clean new start as a faithful follower and believer in Jesus, who paid the ultimate price. I will learn and practice His teachings with love, in honour of my Lord's sacrifice."

Shiloh's story reminds me of the Apostle Philip's encounter with the Ethiopian eunuch in Acts 8. God told Philip to stay near the Ethiopian in his chariot, where he was reading Scripture yet not understanding it. The encounter ended with the Ethiopian becoming baptized with a new faith!

Because of your support, missionaries today are coming alongside Jewish seekers to help them not only gain access to the Word of God, but also to understand its words - and then welcoming new brothers and sisters into our family in Messiah!

Thanks for helping us as winter is heavily upon all of you in Australia and New Zealand, and as our teams in Israel and around the globe continue to share the Good News of Yeshua with all of our Jewish people.

# Thank You for Helping Us Reach Jewish People in Poland!

Inna and her family are refugees from Ukraine. We met at a Jewish organization in Warsaw, where Inna was expecting a permit for *Aliyah* (the term used for Jewish people seeking citizenship in Israel). Unfortunately, her family was denied because of a mistake on the application.

Inna's Jewish background was mostly secular, but recently she has been thinking more about God, and finding comfort in the prayer book. Her husband has cancer, and it's often in the midst of suffering and uncertainty that people turn to God. Inna was ready and willing to hear about Yeshua (Jesus). She asked some good questions and listened as I answered. Then it was my turn to ask a question: "Have you ever asked God to forgive your sins?"

Inna listened as I explained sin and the need for repentance, how Yeshua is the door to a relationship with God, and how He will come into our hearts if we want to receive Him. When I offered to pray with Inna to repent and receive Jesus, she agreed, and we prayed. I also prayed for Inna's husband and for her family to solve the Aliyah problem. We are so grateful for your partnership with Jews for Jesus that helps us introduce Jewish people like Inna to Messiah Jesus!

# **Trusting God** in the Face of Trauma

7e often hear about trauma these days, and much has been uncovered about the longterm debilitating effects of atrocities years after they have occurred. The Nazi Holocaust is an especially pernicious example. It not only traumatized its victims, but in a way, it also traumatized those who didn't speak out against Hitler when he twisted the Bible for his own evil purposes. And so, for years, many Christians have felt that the Holocaust took away their right to talk to Jewish people about Jesus. How Satan must have loved that! We don't talk a lot about Satan in our newsletter, but the adversary does hate what God loves. We believe that acts of antisemitism have a spiritual component, and that the devil inspires hatred and tries to use it to prevent people, especially Jewish people, from knowing the love of God.

Avi Snyder, one of our senior leaders, has been especially instrumental in seeing to it that Jews for Jesus has gospel outreaches in those places where Jewish people perished in the Holocaust. We want people to know that God sent His own Son, Jesus, to the cross where He suffered the unimaginable trauma of fully unleashed sin. And He did it so that we could be forgiven for our own sin and healed of whatever sins have been committed against us.

Still, it's difficult for people who have experienced trauma to trust anyone, let alone God. It can be a long process. That was the case for Edna in Budapest. Edna is a Holocaust survivor. In June 2021, she said "Yes" to receiving Jesus. But the very next day, she recanted because she was afraid of what her family would say. Our missionaries Kata and Ildiko kept meeting with her, sharing the gospel and the hope of heaven. This past spring, Edna had a stroke and was hospitalized. Kata and Ildiko visited her in the hospital and continued to talk about heaven and forgiveness,

but she always asked them, "Where was God when the Holocaust happened?" One day when they visited her in the hospital, she was remarkably better, not only physically, but spiritually. Her heart had softened, and she sincerely prayed to receive Jesus into her heart as her Savior.

Edna is one of many Holocaust survivors you are helping our Budapest staff to reach for Jesus. Rachel, a 93-year-old survivor, has been attending our events for Holocaust survivors with her son Ervin. At first, they both identified themselves as atheists, but over time, they began talking as if they were believers. Several months ago they attended an event, and at the end, Kata offered a prayer thanking God for canceling our debt of sin through Yeshua. She then asked who'd prayed this prayer in their hearts. Ervin said that he and his mother had repented and prayed for Yeshua's forgiveness! Please pray for faith to grow and mature in the hearts of these new Jewish believers in Budapest.

Thanks be to God for building trust in His Messiah, even in hearts that have been traumatized. And thanks be to God for partners like you, who help us be messengers of that trust.


